

ATTENTION

STUDENT will improve ability to concentrate, by attending to the reading of **Thank You for the Strawberries** for 3-5 minutes.

STUDENT will work on classroom assignments related to **Thank You for the Strawberries**, for 3-5 minutes and stay focused until completed in 4/5 opportunities.

RECEPTIVE and EXPRESSIVE VOCABULARY

STUDENT will demonstrate understanding of age-appropriate receptive vocabulary including identifying nouns, action verbs and adjectives (size/shape/color/texture, etc.) by pointing to pictures in the book **Thank You for the Strawberries** when given verbal labels, in 8/10 trials.

STUDENT will label and describe 8/10 pictures and objects while reading **Thank You for the Strawberries** and doing related activities.

FOLLOWING DIRECTIONS

STUDENT will follow 1-step/2-step/3-step verbal directions to complete a task in the **Thank You for the Strawberries Activity Book** with 80% accuracy, in 4 out of 5 opportunities with/without prompting.

STUDENT will follow 1-step/2-step/3-step verbal directions with modifiers- (Location/ spatial concepts, - Quantity - number, more/less, Quality - size, color, shape or pronouns to complete a task in the **Thank You for the Strawberries Activity Book** with 80% accuracy, in 4 out of 5 opportunities



SEQUENCING

STUDENT will independently/with prompting as needed/with up to three verbal prompts sequence a series of 3-10 events in **Thank You for the Strawberries**, as first, next, and last, by placing pictures in correct order, with 80% accuracy, in 4 out of 5 opportunities.

STUDENT will verbally relate the sequence of 3-10 events in **Thank You for the Strawberries**, in correct order, using the words first, then, next, after that, last, finally, with 80% accuracy in 4/5 trials.

STUDENT will retell the story **Thank You for the Strawberries** in the correct order with 80% accuracy.

THINKING MAPS / GRAPHIC ORGANIZERS

STUDENT will use **graphic organizers** to record and organize information from **Thank You for the Strawberries** in a variety of ways with 80% accuracy in 4 out of 5 trials as evidenced by student work samples and teacher recorded data.

STUDENT will use graphic organizers to respond to questions regarding **Thank You for the Strawberries** with 80% accuracy.

STUDENT will use graphic organizers to retell **Thank You for the Strawberries** in correct sequence with 80% accuracy in 4 out of 5 trials.

STUDENT will use graphic organizers to categorize and organize information from **Thank You for the Strawberries** with 80% accuracy.

READING, RECALL, NARRATIVE

STUDENT will correctly respond to questions about **Thank You for the Strawberries** after it is read to them using visual cues / without visual cues with 80% accuracy.

STUDENT will recall 10 details from **Thank You for the Strawberries**, after s/he has just read/heard the story, including characters, actions, sequence, by selecting the correct picture in the activities, in 8/10 opportunities.

STUDENT will verbally sequence the story, **Thank You for the Strawberries**, in correct order, using descriptive and transitional language (first, then, next, after that, last, finally) and visual cues, including the book, and completed graphic organizers, with 80% accuracy.

STUDENT will produce an oral narrative, and retell the story, **Thank You for the Strawberries**, in complete, grammatically correct sentences, using visual aids, with 80% accuracy.

STUDENT will identify critical features of the **Thank You for the Strawberries** story (who, what, when, where, how, why) with 80% accuracy.



YES/NO and WH QUESTIONS
STUDENT will correctly respond to 4/5 questions about Thank You for the Strawberries , using visual aids, with 80% accuracy.
STUDENT will answer questions about Thank You for the Strawberries in 3-4 word phrases/full sentences with 80% accuracy.
STUDENT will demonstrate comprehension of WH questions by pointing at correct pictures in response to questions such as Can you show me the?, Do you see a?, Which one is the?, Where is the?, Can you show me which one happened first?, Who is (the)? while reading Thank You for the Strawberries and doing activities in the Thank You for the Strawberries Activity Book in 8/10 trials.

STUDENT will answer age-appropriate 'yes/no' questions related to **Thank You for the Strawberries** in a variety of contexts, (e.g. while reading the book, having classroom discussions, and relating relevant personal experiences) with 80% accuracy.

STUDENT will correctly answer WH questions (who, what, when, where, why, how) related to **Thank You for the Strawberries** in a variety of contexts, (e.g. while reading the book, having classroom discussions, and relating relevant personal experiences) with 80% accuracy.



EXPRESSIVE LANGUAGE, MLU, SYNTAX

STUDENT will respond accurately to YES/NO and WH questions about **Thank You for the Strawberries** (i.e. answer "who" with a person, "where" with a place, using visual cues/with no more than one repetition of the question, in 8/10 opportunities.

STUDENT will correctly respond to WH questions related to **Thank You for the Strawberries**, with verbal responses of single words to 3-word phrases in 4/5 trials with 80% accuracy.

STUDENT will retell the story **Thank You for the Strawberries** using phrases/complete sentences in 4/5 trials with 80% accuracy.

STUDENT will correctly respond to WH questions related to **Thank You for the Strawberries**, in complete sentences with correct grammar in 4/5 trials with 80% accuracy.

STUDENT will form grammatically correct sentences while answering questions and doing activities related to **Thank You for the Strawberries** with 80% accuracy.

STUDENT will use correct syntax including subject-verb agreement in sentences, present tense, prepositions, to describe or respond to questions regarding **Thank You for the Strawberries** story, illustrations and activities with 80% accuracy.

STUDENT will increase utterance length to 2/4/6 words in 80% of opportunities while answering questions, participating in activities and retelling **Thank You for the Strawberries**.

STUDENT will use 2-3 word utterances to describe, to ask questions/comment/describe while answering questions, participating in activities and retelling **Thank You for the Strawberries**.



PRAGMATICS - SOCIAL LANGUAGE - CONVERSATION

STUDENT will initiate and participate in a back and forth conversation exchange about **Thank You for the Strawberries**, with 80% success.

While engaged in reading **Thank You for the Strawberries**, STUDENT will independently comment, ask appropriate questions, and respond correctly to questions for 3-5 conversational turns with 80% success.

STUDENT will maintain a topic of conversation about **Thank You for the Strawberries** while reading the book and completing assignments with 80% accuracy.

STUDENT will demonstrate appropriate turn-taking in conversations about **Thank You for the Strawberries** given a verbal cue and/or visual prompt with 80% accuracy.

STUDENT will maintain conversations by staying on topic and/or making appropriate topic transitions while discussing **Thank You for the Strawberries** for up to 3 exchanges in 4/5 opportunities.
